



## OECU-Doug McKee Scholarship

In an effort to promote learning and advance the academic opportunities of OECU members and their families, the Ontario Educational Credit Union is providing post-secondary education scholarships to deserving students who are members or relatives of Credit Union members.

### The Scholarship

The scholarship is a single payment of \$1,500.

The Credit Union Board of Directors will determine the number of scholarships to be awarded in any given year.

Scholarship winners may reapply in successive years and are eligible to receive one additional scholarship.

### The Applicant

An applicant must be ...

- i. the relative of an active member of OECU in good standing\* for one complete year prior to the application deadline, **or**
- ii. an active member of OECU in good standing\* for one complete year prior to the application deadline.

Staff of OECU, their relatives, and the relatives of OECU directors are eligible to apply as long as they meet the posted eligibility requirements.

*(\* An active member is one who makes regular use of his/her account.)*

### The Application Process

Each applicant must submit, by **Friday, April 30, 2021**:

- i. a completed application form typed; except for the reference letter detailed below, hand-written forms or forms with hand-written sections will not be considered;

(Complete the appropriate application:

- a. **Secondary School Application Form** – use this if you are in secondary school or have not been enrolled in or attended a post-secondary program.

- b. **Post-Secondary School Application Form** – use this if you have been or currently are enrolled in/attending a post-secondary program.)
- ii. his/her most recent secondary school, college or university transcript;
- iii. written confirmation of enrollment or acceptance into a full-time undergraduate post-secondary program at an accredited community college or university;
- iv. a letter of reference from a school official (principal, vice-principal or guidance counselor, professor, or college/university teaching assistant) attesting to the applicant’s degree of commitment to academic success, contribution to the life of the school, leadership skills and likelihood of success in the post-secondary program to which he/she has applied; **or**
- v. a letter of reference from the supervisor of a community/volunteer organization or program attesting to the applicant’s degree of commitment to the organization/program, the success of the applicant’s efforts, and his/her demonstrated leadership skills and/or initiative.

## The Selection Process

Recipients will be chosen by a selection committee consisting of OECU members and suitable arbiters from outside the organization.

Scholarship recipients will be chosen according to their merit. Successful applicants will demonstrate a balance of community involvement, academic achievement, depth of effort applied to the application process, and, depth of effort applied to the interview process, as well as financial need.

The selection process will be “blind” and will include the following features:

- a. OECU directors or staff will not sit on the selection committee;
- b. applicants’ personal information will appear only on the cover sheet of the application form;
- c. the cover sheet will be removed before the applications are forwarded to the selection committee;
- d. applicants will be identified to the Selection Committee only by an assigned number appearing on all pages of the application form;
- e. letters of reference must be hand-written on the supplied forms, **or** typed in a format that duplicates the format of the supplied forms; *(The point is to ensure that the applicant's personal information is on the first page of the reference letter only and that the body of the text, without personal information, is on the successive page(s).)*
- f. the field of applicants will be reduced by the Selection Committee to a list of finalists who will be interviewed, by appointment, by the Committee.
- g. an interview for each finalist is mandatory and will take place by appointment on **Tuesday, June 8, 2021** ideally at 6435 Edwards Boulevard, Mississauga but with COVID most likely by Zoom.

## **Submitting the Application**

Ensure that all sections of the application form are completed.

Ensure that all required documents are enclosed in the envelope:

- ✓ completed application form (typed as per instructions on the form),
- ✓ most recent secondary school, college or university transcript,
- ✓ written confirmation of college/university enrollment/acceptance,
- ✓ letter of reference – school official, or community/volunteer program supervisor.
